NORTH AFRICA




North Africa is one of the most spiritually unreached regions in the world. Despite its religious past and historical ties to early Christianity, most of its people have little access to the gospel today. The spiritual darkness and resistance in this region make it important for Christians to share the gospel here, pray regularly, and work well together.

STATS AND FACTS

- North African countries are mostly Muslim. Less than 2% of the population in most North African countries is Christian.
- Many people groups are unreached, especially in the Sahel and along the Sahara's southern edge.
- There are 527 unreached people groups within North Africa.
- Number of people in Northern Africa who die daily without Christ: 8,447

PRAYER

- Pray for underdeveloped areas and hard-to-access people groups. Travel is difficult because of harsh climate, long distances, and rough roads.
- Pray language and cultural barriers can be broken. Many remote groups speak unique languages or dialects and have distinct cultural practices that require specialized approaches to communicate the gospel.



MIDDLE EAST



The Middle East is the historic heartland of the Christian faith, yet today it is one of the least reached regions in the world. Although it is the birthplace of Jesus and the early church, this region is now home to millions of people who have never heard the true gospel.

Many sub-Saharan Africans, including Christians, live and work in Middle Eastern countries. They work in places like the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, and Saudi Arabia, often in education, healthcare, and business.

STATS AND FACTS

- In most Middle Eastern countries, less than 5% of the population is Christian. In some countries, less than 1% of the population is Christian.
- The region is home to millions of refugees and displaced people, many of whom have never heard the gospel.
- Number of people in the Middle East who die daily without Christ: 1,375

PRAYER

- Pray that God will continue to make Himself known through dreams, visions, and miraculous experiences, which lead to true gospel understanding.
- Pray for peace in areas of conflict, for justice for the oppressed, and for leaders to govern with wisdom and compassion.



EUROPE



Europe is home to many cultures, languages, and histories, yet many European countries are increasingly nonreligious and spiritually uninterested.

The recent data says- Europe is home to approximately 565 million Christians, which is about 75% of the continent's population. However, it's important to know that while many Europeans call themselves Christians because of their traditions or cultures, a much smaller percentage are active, practicing believers.

STATS AND FACTS

- More than 12 million Europeans are unreached and still not engaged by church planting strategies.
- Many in the Catholic and Orthodox churches hope their works will save them.
- Many sub-Saharan Africans in Europe are students, workers, or refugees.
- Number of people in Europe who die daily without knowing Christ: 16,956



PRAYER


- Pray for spiritual renewal in traditional and historic churches. Pray that they will rediscover the power of the gospel and become centers of mission once again.
- Pray for boldness and wisdom for local believers and workers as they share the gospel. Pray that they will speak with grace and truth.

CHINA

China is one of the world's most influential nations. It is home to more than 1.4 billion people and a rapidly changing society. Recently, China has also become a destination for many Africans. Students, businesspeople, and workers seek education and opportunity. This movement of people creates new opportunities for gospel witness and cross-cultural ministry, even in a country where open Christian activity is often restricted.

STATS AND FACTS

- It is estimated that tens of thousands of Africans live in China. Cities like Guangzhou, Beijing, and Shanghai have large African communities.
- Although China has a large Christian population, the government tightly controls religious activity, and unregistered “house churches” often face harassment, surveillance, or closure.
- Number of people in China who die daily without knowing Christ: 30,585

PRAYER

- Ask God to strengthen and unite Chinese and African believers. Pray that they will encourage one another and be bold witnesses for Christ.
- Pray that African believers in China will be trained and empowered to share the gospel with fellow Africans and Chinese friends, and that God will use these relationships for His glory.

Across North Africa, West Africa, the Middle East, Europe, and even China, millions of people are living far from their homes because of war, persecution, poverty, or economic hardship. These are known as displaced people groups.

Displacement brings loss, deep pain, and uncertainty, but it also creates opportunities for the gospel. Churches and believers in host countries have opportunities to welcome, serve, and share Christ with those who may have never heard the gospel.

STATS AND FACTS

- As of 2024, there are more than 110 million forcibly displaced people worldwide.
- In the Sahel region (places like Mali, Burkina Faso, and Niger), more than 3 million people have had to leave their homes because of violence and danger.
- The Middle East and North Africa region continues to face economic, political, and security challenges. Some 16.6 million forcibly displaced and stateless people are living in the region.
- Europe hosts millions of refugees and asylum seekers, many from the Middle East and Africa.
- China is not a major destination for refugees, but it has a significant number of internal migrants. More than 375 million people have moved from rural to urban areas for work, often facing social and economic challenges.

PRAYER

- Pray that God will protect displaced people from harm, provide for their physical needs (food, shelter, medical care), and grant them safety on their journeys.
- Ask God to restore what has been lost, to give hope for the future, and to guide displaced people to places of safety, community, and opportunity.

LEAST REACHED PEOPLE GROUPS




Across the world there are millions of people who have little or no access to the gospel. These are known as unreached people groups.

An unreached people group is a community among whom there is no Christian church with enough believers and resources to evangelize their own people without outside help. In many cases, less than 2% of the population is evangelical Christian. They may have no local church, no Bible in their language, and no believers at all.

STATS AND FACTS

- Most of the people groups in North Africa are considered unreached. Less than 0.1% of the population in many North African countries is Christian.
- Sub-saharan Africa has nearly 1,600 unreached people groups remaining.
- Most countries in the Middle East have large populations with little or no access to the gospel, including Arabs, Kurds, Persians, Turks, and Bedouins.
- While Europe has a Christian heritage, growing numbers of unreached people groups live there, especially among immigrants, refugees, and nonreligious populations.
- China is home to hundreds of distinct ethnic groups. Many are considered as unreached.

PRAYER

- Pray that Bibles, audio Scriptures, and gospel resources will be available in every language and format that these groups need.
- Pray that God will send more believers to share the gospel among unreached peoples.
