


- <2% of population is evangelical Christian

- A people group might remain unengaged even when it has been adopted, is the object of focused prayer, or is part of an advocacy strategy.




Unreached People Groups (UPG)

A Disciple

The church is made up of disciples of Jesus Christ. Disciples are followers of Jesus. They have turned from their sin and trusted in Jesus as their Savior. They have died to themselves and surrendered their lives to Him as Lord. They live lives transformed by the gospel. All of us who are born again are disciples of Jesus Christ and have a part to play in the Great Commission. (Matthew 28:16-20; Mark 1:17; Luke 6:40; Romans 8:29)

A Missionary

A missionary is a disciple of Jesus set apart by the Holy Spirit, sent out from the church, and affirmed to cross geographic, cultural, and/or linguistic barriers to focus on making disciples and multiplying churches among unreached peoples and places. (Matthew 28:16–20; Acts 1:8; 13:1–3)

A Pastor/Elder/Bishop/Overseer

The Bible recognizes two types of leaders in the church: pastors/elders/bishops/overseers and deacons. In the New Testament, the words pastor/shepherd, elder, bishop, and overseer are used interchangeably and refer to the same office (Acts 20:17, 28; Titus 1:5-7; 1 Peter 5:1-4.) The qualifications for these leaders are given in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9.

Evangelism Tools

Evangelism is the proclamation of the gospel in the power of the Holy Spirit with the aim to persuade people to repent and believe in Christ.

1. Two Kingdoms Gospel Presentation.
2. Creation to Christ

Baptism Study

The meaning of Baptism and how, who, why, and when a person should be baptized.

1. Read: Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-11

Conclusion: Followers of Jesus should be baptized like Jesus was baptized.

2. Read: Matthew 28:18-20

Conclusion: Jesus said that His followers should be baptized.

3. Read Romans 6:1-5

Conclusion: Baptism symbolizes a believer's repentance and death to their past sinful living, their burial, and hope and belief in Jesus' resurrection and their own. It shows their readiness to "walk in newness of life," in Christ.

4. Read Galatians 3:26-28

Baptism symbolizes our unity with Christ and with other believers as children of God, without division.

3. Biblical Discipleship – Tools

SOS Method

- 1. Scripture:** What does the passage say?
- 2. Observation:** How do I apply the truths that are stated in my life?
- 3. Share:** How can I share these truths with others?
Who can I share them with?
When will I share this with them?

SPEC Method

- S – Sin to Avoid:** Does the passage reveal ungodly behaviors, attitudes, or actions that I need to change?
- P - Promise to claim:** What promises do I see that I need to apply to my life?
- E – Example to follow:** Are there examples of faith, character, or actions that I see that I need to exemplify in my life? What are they?
- C – Command to obey:** Are there commands in the passage that I must obey? How do I plan to do that?


